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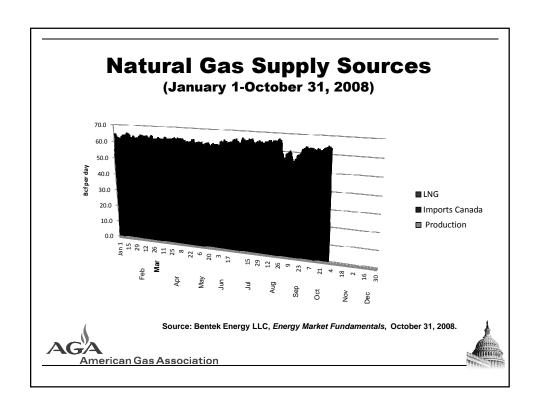


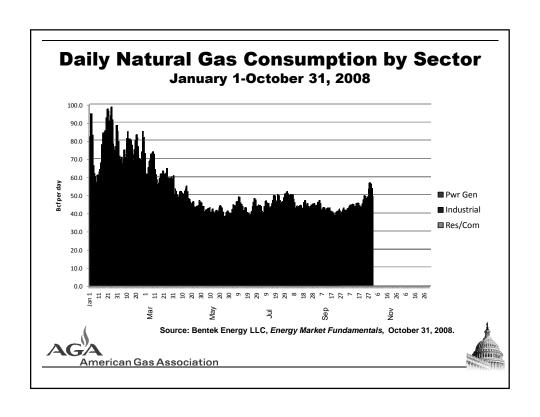
Current Natural Gas Supply Summary

 - ✓ uneven picture for LNG



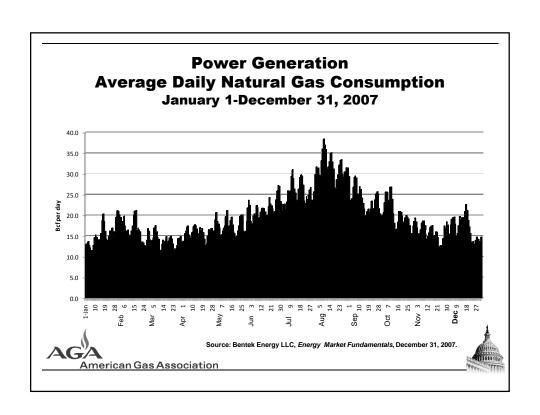


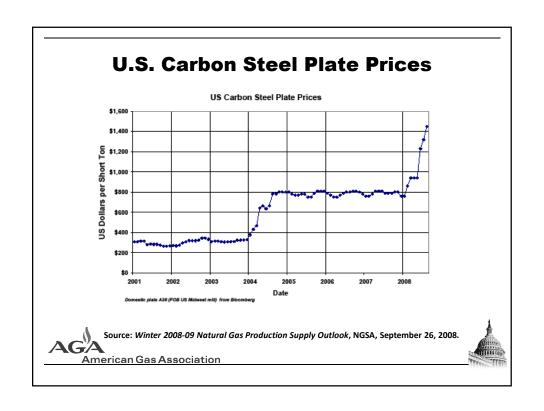


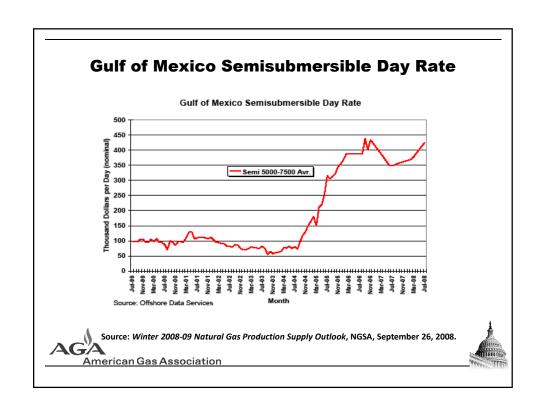


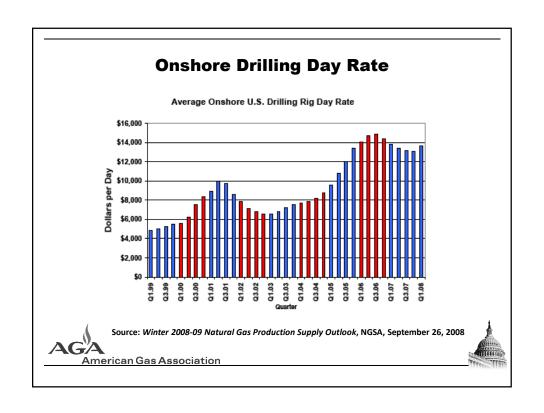
Changes in Sector Demand

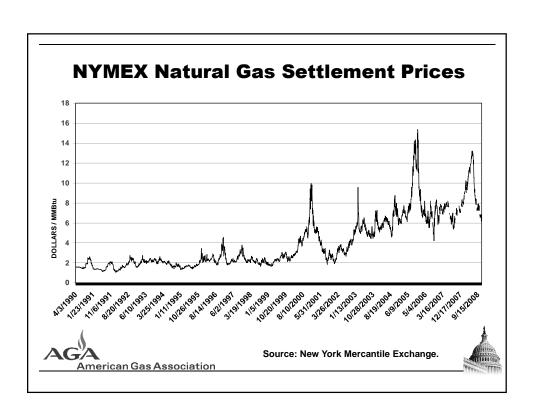
U.S. Natural Gas Consumption by Sector	1997	2002	2007
